

## Rules for visiting the “Synagogue” Center

1. **The “Synagogue” Center (synagogue building situated at 14 Pereca Street in Zamość and the surrounding enclosed area) is the property of the Foundation for the Preservation of Jewish Heritage in Poland with its headquarters in Warsaw, tel. +48 22 436 6000, fax +48 22 436 0658, e-mail: [fodz@fodz.pl](mailto:fodz@fodz.pl).**

3. The Center is open to visitors Tuesday through Sunday. The Center is closed on Mondays, bank holidays and Jewish holidays.
4. Between November 2nd and February 28th/29th the Center is open from 9.00 am to 5.00 pm, last visitors enter the Center at 4.40 pm. Between March 1st and October 31st the Center is open from 10.00 am to 6.00 pm, last visitors enter the Center at 5.40 pm.
5. During the visit, please follow all directions given by the Center employees.
6. Organized groups are to notify the Owner of the planned date and time of their arrival as well as the number of persons visiting at least 7 days prior to the visit. The Owner will issue a written permission form which the person responsible for the group will be obliged to present upon arrival. Groups which do not follow the above procedure may not be able to enter the Center.
7. Filming and taking photographs inside the building is only allowed without the use of flash.
8. Publishing photographs of the building requires the written permission of the Owner.
9. Mobile phones should be turned off during the visit. Visitors are asked to keep voice levels reasonably low and to have appropriate dress (covered shoulders and back).
10. The following are strictly forbidden in the synagogue and the enclosed area surrounding it:
  - Indecent behavior or any behavior posing a danger to persons or property;
  - The possession of firearms or any type of dangerous materials;
  - Consuming or bringing in food and drink, chewing gum, smoking or lighting a fire;
  - Bringing animals into the Center or the surrounding enclosed area.
11. Persons who are intoxicated or behaving inappropriately will not be permitted within the Center and the surrounding enclosed area.
12. Employees of the Center are authorized to refuse entry to any persons breaching these regulations and may ask them to leave the Center area.
